## Quarterly report summary - July 2023

Overall, healthcare indicators of harm and service use remained broadly stable up to May 2023.

The predominant picture of drug harms in Scotland continues to be polydrug use involving benzodiazepines, cocaine and opioids.

Current alerts: New benzodiazepines - bromazolam (July 2023) and Nitazene-type opioids (March 2023)



### NALOXONE ADMINISTRATIONS | MAR 23 - MAY 23

- Average weekly number of ambulance service incidents increased between March (66) and May (79).
- Total number of incidents (973) lower compared to the same period in 2021 (1,223) and similar to 2022 (959).





### SUSPECTED DRUG DEATHS | MAR 23 - MAY 23

- Average of 100 suspected drug deaths per month.
- This was lower compared to approximately the same period in 2021 (116) and similar to the same period 2022 (102).





## A&E ATTENDANCES | MAR 23 - MAY 23

- Total of 1,081 drug-related attendances recorded.
- This was similar compared to the same period in 2021 (1,058) and 13% higher than in 2022 (954).





## **HOSPITAL ADMISSIONS** | JAN 23 - MAR 23

- Average weekly number of drug-related hospital admissions decreased during this time period.
- Total number of admissions (1,654) was lower than expected, compared to the same period in 2021 (3,040) and 2022 (2,136) (decreases of 23% and 46% respectively).



### TOXICOLOGY

#### **Emergency departments**

Feb 23 - May 23

Most common drug types detected were benzodiazepines (60%), followed by **opioids** (17%).

#### **Post-mortem testing**

Oct 22 - Dec 22

Most common drug types detected were opioids (75%) and benzodiazepines (62%). Bromazolam was detected in 15% of deaths.

#### **Prison testing**

Jan 23 - Mar 23

Most common drug types detected were benzodiazepines (21%) and synthetic cannabinoids (19%).

### SERVICES

#### **Treatment**

Feb 23 - May 23

Average weekly number of referrals to specialist drug treatment services was broadly stable.

Number of referrals (5,573) was **lower** than the same period in 2021 (6,531) and **similar** to 2022 (5,625).

### **Opioid Substitution Therapy**

Jan 23 - Mar 23

Average number of doses supplied per month was **stable**.

Number of doses supplied was slightly lower than the same period in 2021 and 2022.

# **Injecting Equipment Provision**

Jan 23 - Mar 23

Average weekly number of IEP transactions and number of syringes and needles distributed were broadly stable.

Number of transactions during this time period was **lower** than the same period in 2021 and 2022.
